Erasmus+ Projects Panevėžio 5-oji gimnazija, Lithuania Assessment Criteria

When any project is confirmed and school gets the grant, preparation activities for the project begin.

The project coordinator at school organizes meetings for teachers, students and parents to inform them about the aim, goals, objectives and activities of the project.

The selection of teachers, members of the project team, is based on the theme of the project, on their digital and communicative skills, management activities.

The members of the team discuss necessary material resources to ensure the conduct of the proposed activities and to achieve the designed objectives: digital equipment, tools necessary for scientific experiments, stationary goods.

The selection of students for LTT (Learning Teaching Training) activities is as follows:

- student's interest, motivation and willingness to engage in a European project;
- filling in the application form of participation;
- choosing activities, a student team member will be involved in;
- task fulfillment in time, time management;
- evaluating assignments fulfilled;
- assessing and writing points for each activity;
- the English language knowledge is tested at an interview;
- computer skills are tested as well;
- interviews with teachers and / or class teachers if necessary;
- the points are summarized approximately one month before LTT;
- students who have the maximum point score are selected;
- under regulations of COVID-19 situation, students possessing EU digital COVID Certificate are involved.
